General	Steady descent of 355 metres (1165 feet) through hardwood Acadian forest to a small cove on the Gulf of St. Lawrence (Atlantic Ocean), once home to several Acadian families and a small lobster cannery. Prime example of the 17 forested canyons in the park. Whales, eagles, gannets and kingfishers can be seen in the cove.	Length	15.7 km (9.8 mi) return Alternate route is 5.7 km return
