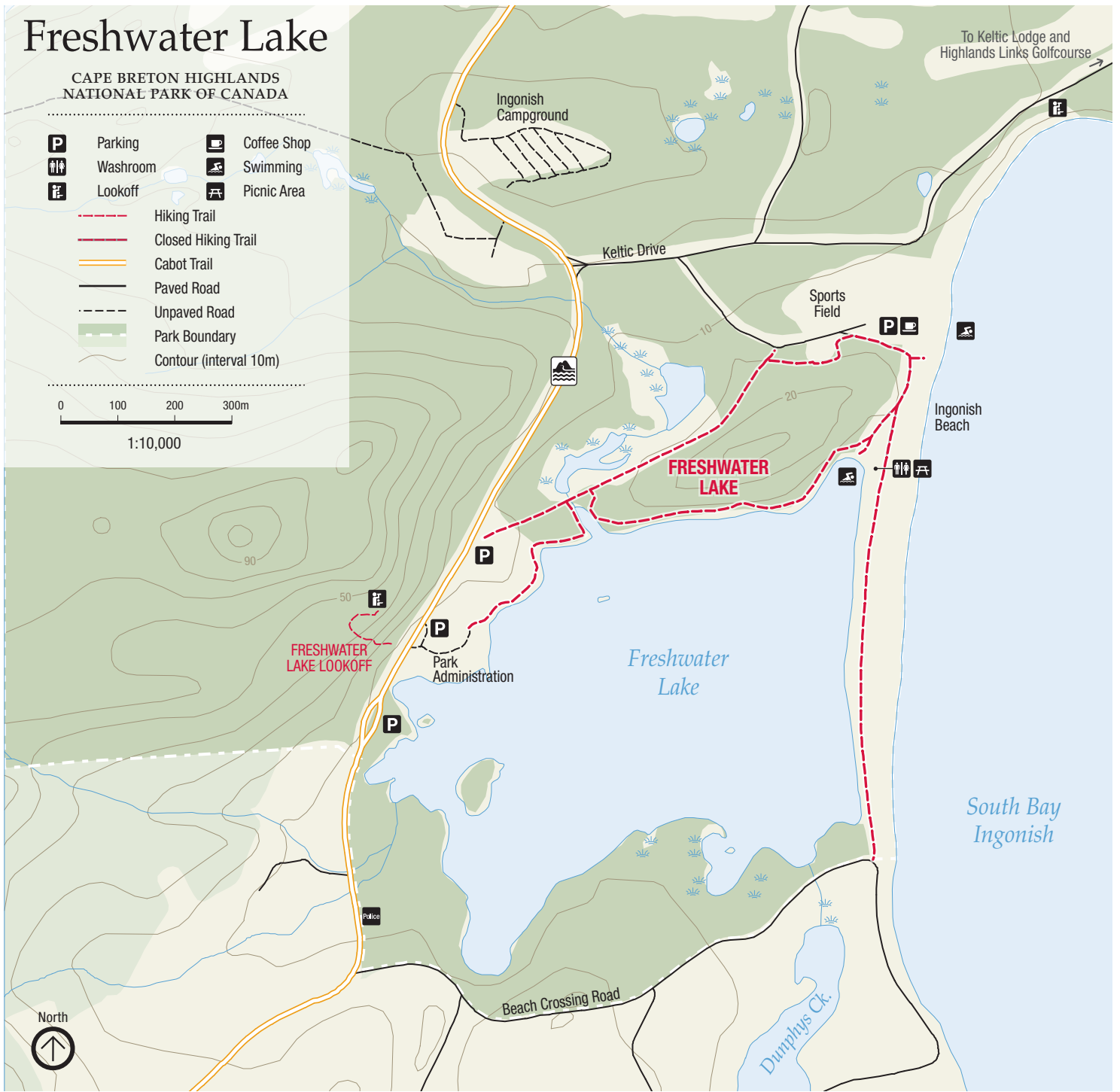

| General | A loop trail overlooking the Atlantic coastline and winding through a post-fire Jack Pine stand. Jack Pine in this area is significant because it is separated from the rest of its range by several hundred kilometres. Jack Pine is uncommon in Cape Breton. Scenic views along the coast with opportunities to explore cobblestone beaches, rocky headlands and coastal barrens. | Length    | 2.3km (1.4mi) loop trail |
